The CCL-EAR committee has received numerous inquiries regarding *Greenwood Daily Life Online*. This product has recently been renamed *Daily Life Through History* because the company is adding other databases to its “suite” of products under the title *Daily Life Online*. Select members of the committee undertook a brief trial of the product and found it a worthwhile addition for community college libraries. In addition to entries from the *Greenwood Encyclopedia of Daily Life*, the database has primary documents, images, and links to web resources. The interface is user friendly, and allows searching by keyword, time period, and region.
